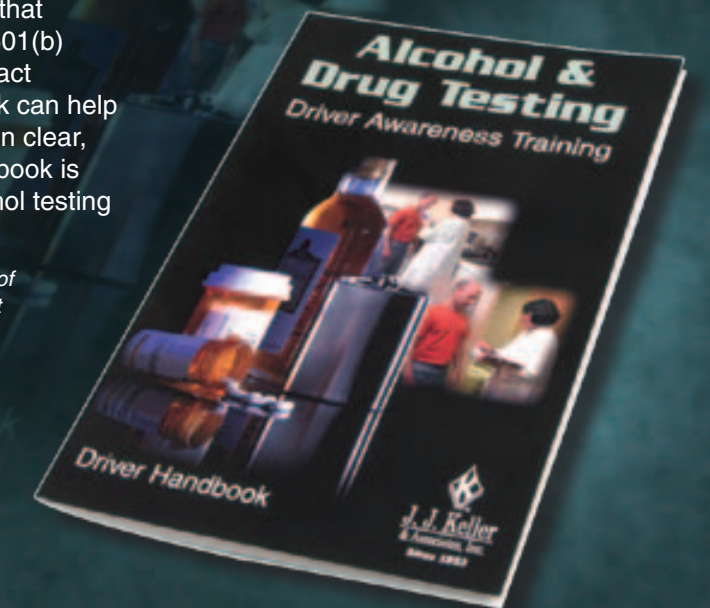
Shows a re-enactment of a typical breath alcohol test screening and the equipment used.
